DAY 1: FLIGHT TO WARSAW

(Sun. Sept. 20) Today, your pilgrimage begins as you depart on your international overnight flight to Poland. Now it's time to relax, enjoy your flight, and focus on the incredible spiritual journey ahead.

DAY 2: ARRIVAL IN WARSAW

(Mon. Sept. 21) Upon arrival in Warsaw, you will be greeted by your tour director and driver. We will transfer to the hotel for our welcome dinner and first overnight stay in Warsaw.

DAY 3: WARSAW | Feast Day of St. John Paul II

(Tues. Sept. 22) After breakfast at our hotel, we will visit St. James Church, where Helena Kowalska prayed and asked Fr. James Dabrowski for advice, which resulted in Helena entering the convent and becoming Sister Faustina. Mass will be celebrated. We will also explore the Old Town, which features cobblestone streets and stunning architecture, and visit the Market Square and the Warsaw Ghetto Monument commemorating the Warsaw Ghetto Uprising of 1943. Enjoy the rest of the afternoon exploring on your own, then return to your hotel for dinner and overnight accommodations.

DAY 4: WARSAW | CZESTOCHOWA | KRAKOW

(Wed. Sept. 23) Following breakfast and hotel check-out, we will travel to Czestochowa, the spiritual heart of Poland and a favorite pilgrimage site of St. John Paul II. We will visit the national shrine of Jasna Gora (meaning ‘Bright Mountain’) and the Chapel of Our Lady, home to the beloved Black Madonna. According to tradition, it was painted by St. Luke the Evangelist and later discovered by St. Helena, who enshrined it. After celebrating Mass, enjoy the peaceful, holy grounds of Jasna Gora Monastery, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, before continuing to Krakow and checking into our hotel for dinner and overnight accommodations.

DAY 5: KRAKOW

(Thurs. Sept. 24) Today, after breakfast, we will visit Wawel Hill to see the beautiful Cathedral and Coronation Chapel, where we will have the opportunity to pray at the tomb of St. Stanislaus, the patron saint of Poland. After, we will explore Krakow's Market Square, which has remained unchanged for almost 700 years, and tour St. Mary's Basilica. Enjoy the rest of the afternoon at leisure. Dinner will be on your own.

DAY 6: WADOWICE | KRAKOW

(Fri. Sept. 25) This morning after breakfast, we will travel to Wadowice, the birthplace of Saint John Paul II. We will visit the church in the market square, now known as the Papal Basilica of the Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary in Wadowice, where he was baptized, made his First Confession, received his First Holy Communion, and served as an altar boy. Mass will be celebrated. Next door to the basilica, we will visit his childhood home, which is now a museum dedicated to his life and pilgrimages. Enjoy lunch and the rest of the afternoon at leisure. Be sure to try the famous ‘Pope's cake’, a must while in Wadowice! After our visit, we will head back to Krakow for dinner and overnight accommodations at your hotel.

DAY 7: ZAKOPANE | KRAKOW













(Sat. Sept. 26) Following breakfast, we will drive to the small, remote village of Zakopane, St. John Paul II's favorite place for recreation and relaxation. We will visit the Fatima Church, which the mountaineers built in gratitude for the Blessed Mother saving St. John Paul II's life from the assassination attempt in 1981. St. John Paul II visited and blessed this church in 1999. Mass will be celebrated. Next, we will take the gondola to Mt. Glubowka for a magnificent panoramic view of the city and hillside trails St. John

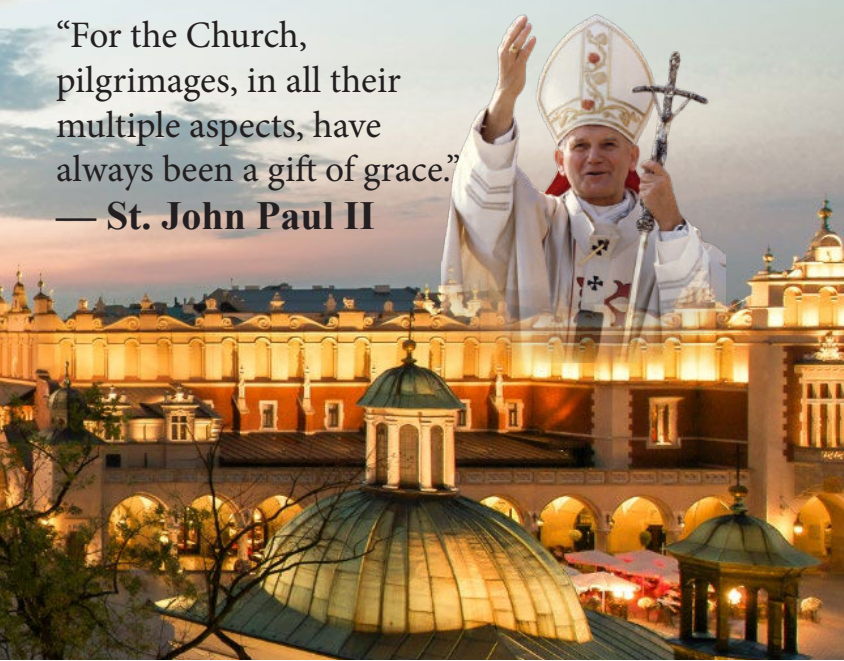

DAY 8: SHRINE OF DIVINE MERCY | KRAKOW

(Sun. Sept. 27) Today, we will travel to Lagiewniki, where the message of the Divine Mercy began. We will pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet before the tomb of St. Faustina Kowalska. Next, we will tour the convent and the Basilica of Divine Mercy, which was consecrated by St. John Paul II on his last trip to Poland. We will also visit the St. Faustina Chapel of Divine Mercy. We will celebrate Mass and visit the St. John Paul II Center, where we will see his relics. We will return to Krakow for dinner and overnight accommodations at your hotel.

DAY 9: AUSCHWITZ | KRAKOW

(Mon. Sept. 28) After breakfast, we will drive to Auschwitz, the largest World War II concentration camp in Europe. We will take a guided tour, including the Shrine of St. Maximilian Kolbe, where he gave his life for the life of another prisoner. Then, we will travel to the area of Oswiecim and Harmeze where Mass will be celebrated. Afterward, we will return to Krakow. Dinner will be on our own.

DAY 10: WIELICZKA | KRAKOW

(Tues. Sept. 29) After breakfast, we will travel to the Wieliczka Salt Mine, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, where you will be transported to a mystifying world of salt beneath the Earth's surface. It is home to the Chapel of St. Kinga, an exquisite underground church carved out of salt featuring a salt sculpture of Saint John Paul II. After celebrating Mass, you are free to enjoy the afternoon at leisure. Our farewell dinner will be at a local restaurant.

DAY 11: RETURN HOME

(Wed. Sept. 30) Our pilgrimage comes to a close today as we depart Krakow on our return flight home, taking with us incredible memories that will last a lifetime.

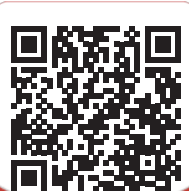

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

YOUR PACKAGE INCLUDES

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

Land Transportation: All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotels: Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Meal Plan: The meal plan offers breakfast & dinner daily, unless otherwise stated.

Tips/Gratuities: This includes tour guides, drivers, hotel service staff, and wait staff.

Baggage: Most airlines limit passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions.

Airport Fees: Airport Taxes, Portage, Fuel Surcharges and Security Fees

Medical Insurance: Medical coverage for the duration of your trip.

YOUR PACKAGE DOES NOT INCLUDE

Cancellation Insurance: We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

Passport Expenses: This includes any passports or additional travel documents that may be required. Passports must be valid until at least 6 months from your return date.

Personal Expenses: Laundry, beverages (including wine, liquor, mineral water, tea, coffee, etc.), meals or food items not listed on the included menu plan, and any excess or additional luggage.

Non-itinerary fees: Any sightseeing or service fees or personal items that are not specifically mentioned as being included in the itinerary.

Non-included meals: You are responsible for any meals not specified in your itinerary.

GENERAL TRAVEL INFORMATION

Group Air: Group Air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different air rate, ticketing method, or on a different airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

Departure Cities: If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule in order to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the "Land Only" option. This amount equals to the total tour price minus \$800 for all destinations except Mexico, which is minus \$350. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

IMPORTANT POLICIES

The airline selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

Single Room: Tour price is based on double occupancy. If you'd like a single room, there is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Seat Upgrades: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade or seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Other Special Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a special request, such as a wheelchair, food, etc., we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

BOOKING CONDITIONS

Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due 100 Days before departure (06/12/26). Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

Payment Methods: We accept major credit cards, checks, money orders, and Zelle payments. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction.

LATE PAYMENT POLICY

Customers will receive Late Fees if they are not paid in full:

PRIOR TO DEPARTURE	FEE
100 - 61 days	\$150
60 - 30 days	\$300
30 days - day before departure	subject to cancellation

Customers are also responsible for any difference in fare due to late payment (subject to availability). Refusal to pay will be considered a cancellation.

CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY

We hope that nothing will prevent you from taking your pilgrimage with Nativity Pilgrimage, however, should you need to cancel your trip, your cancellation must be in writing via email or letter. It will be effective on the date of receipt. The following cancellation fees will apply:

PRIOR TO DEPARTURE	PENALTY
100 + days	Lose deposit
99 - 50 days	50% of trip cost
49 days or less	100% of trip cost

Insurance premiums are non-refundable. We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance to avoid these cancellation fees.

PROTECT YOUR TRIP

Every pilgrim traveling with Nativity will receive complimentary medical insurance that provides coverage for the full duration of your trip.

We also strongly recommend purchasing trip cancellation insurance (available at an additional cost) to safeguard your travel investment in case unforeseen circumstances require you to cancel. Please contact our office for details about trip cancellation insurance options.

Important: If you plan to purchase Cancel for Any Reason (CFAR) coverage, it must be purchased at the time of registration.
