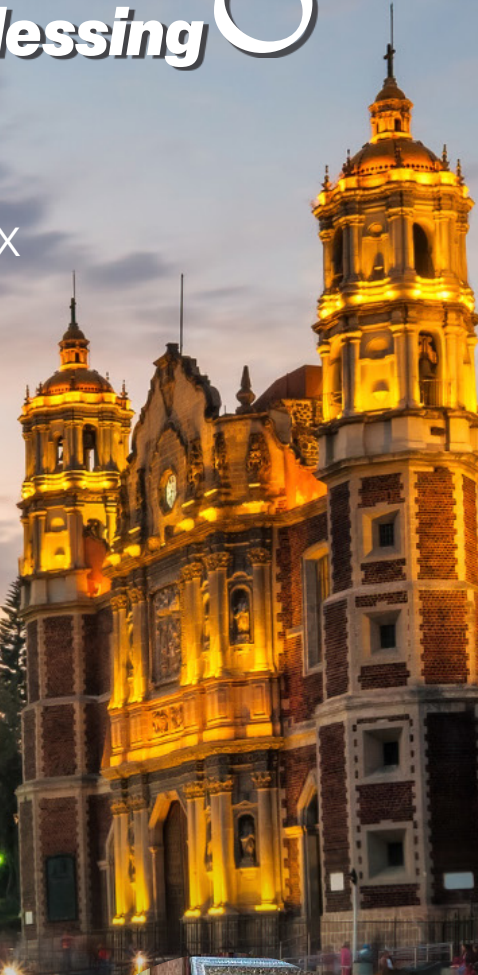

DAY 1: FLIGHT TO MEXICO CITY

Our pilgrimage begins today as we board our flight to Mexico City. Upon arrival, we will transfer to our hotel and check in. We will have a Welcome Mass at the hotel, and later, gather for cocktails and appetizers before dinner, accompanied by live music.

DAY 2: THE BEST OF MEXICO CITY

This morning, we will also celebrate Mass with Archbishop Gomez at the Metropolitan Cathedral. Afterwards we'll head to the Plaza of the Three Cultures, showcasing pre-Hispanic, colonial, and modern influences. Next, we'll visit the Templo de Santiago to see Juan Diego's baptismal font, followed by the Metropolitan Cathedral and the Chapel of the Miraculous Cross of Poison. We'll then explore the National Palace, home to Mexico's ruling class since Aztec times. A stroll along the pedestrian alley of Francisco y Madero will lead us to the Casa de los Azulejos, Temple of San Francisco, and Temple of San Felipe Neri, which features a significant art gallery from the 17th to 19th centuries. Finally, we'll stop by the Palacio de Iturbide and the Church of la Sagrada Familia to pray for Blessed Miguel Pro. We'll end the day with an authentic Mexican taco dinner before returning to our hotel.

DAY 3: OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE

Today, we will celebrate mass with Archbishop Gomez at the Basilica Our Lady of Guadalupe, with other pilgrims from the archdiocese of Los Angeles. This remarkable church is one of the most significant Catholic pilgrimage sites. Throughout the day, we'll engage in a variety of spiritual experiences, such as kneeling before the centuries-old Tilma, ascending Tepeyac Hill, and exploring the Old Basilica, the Chapel of the Indians, and the Chapel of the Well. We'll also participate in Holy Mass led by the Archbishop at the main altar, with time set aside for lunch, prayer, and even some personal shopping. To round off our day,

we'll enjoy dinner at a local restaurant while being serenaded by the lively music of Mariachis.

DAY 4: TULPETLAC | FOLKLORIC BALLET OF MEXICO

After breakfast, we will visit the Church of the 5th Apparition in Tlaxpetlac, where the Blessed Virgin Maria de Guadalupe appeared to Juan Bernardino, Juan Diego's uncle. Here you can find a well of healing water which locals drink from. We will celebrate Mass before returning to our hotel. After dinner at the hotel, we will attend the Folkloric Ballet of Mexico!

DAY 5: TEOTIHUACAN "OPTIONAL"

Get ready for an exciting adventure in San Juan Teotihuacan, one of Mesoamerica's most vibrant cultural hubs. This remarkable archaeological site features monumental structures such as the impressive Citadel, the Temple of the Feathered Serpent, and the awe-inspiring Pyramids of the Sun and Moon. After our guided visit, enjoy free time to explore at your own pace or enhance your experience with optional add-ons designed especially for travelers ages 25–40, including a tequila tasting in downtown Mexico City, a casual bike ride through Chapultepec Forest, or a guided graffiti walk highlighting the city's dynamic street-art culture. Dinner will be on your own, followed by a relaxing overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY 6: PUEBLA

After breakfast, we will travel to Puebla, a colonial town renowned for its rich history. We'll visit St. Francis of Assisi Church to see the incorrupt body of Blessed Sebastian de Aparicio, then celebrate Mass at the beautiful Church of Santo Domingo, home to the famous chapel of Our Lady of the Rosary. After lunch at a traditional Puebla restaurant, we'll return to our hotel in Mexico City for dinner and a relaxing overnight stay.

DAY 7: RETURN HOME

This morning, if time allows, we will say farewell to our Lady or have Mass at one of the nearby churches, followed by a transfer to the airport for your return flight home.

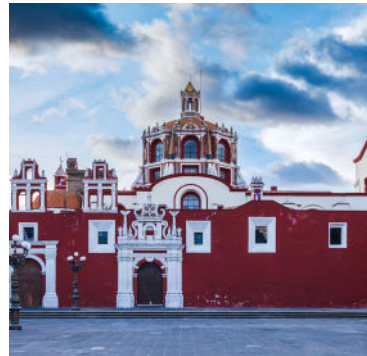

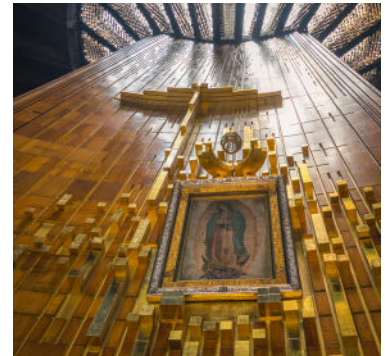

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

YOUR PACKAGE INCLUDES

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

Land Transportation: All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotels: Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Meal Plan: The meal plan offers breakfast & dinner daily, unless otherwise stated.

Baggage: Most airlines limit all passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions.

Airport Fees: Airport Taxes, Portage, Fuel Surcharges and Security Fees

Medical Insurance: Coverage for the duration of your trip.

YOUR PACKAGE DOES NOT INCLUDE

Cancellation Insurance: We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

Passport Expenses: This includes any passports or additional travel documents that may be required. Passports must be valid until at least 6 months from your return date.

Personal Expenses: Laundry, beverages (including wine, liquor, mineral water, tea, coffee, etc.), meals or food items not listed on the included menu plan, and any excess or additional luggage.

Non-itinerary fees: Any sightseeing or service fees or personal items that are not specifically mentioned as being included in the itinerary.

Non-included meals: You are responsible for any meals not specified in your itinerary.

Tips/Gratuities: This includes tour guides, drivers, hotel service staff, and wait staff .

GENERAL TRAVEL INFORMATION

Group Air: Group Air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different air rate, ticketing method, or on a different airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

Departure Cities: If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule in order to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the "Land Only" option. This amount equals to the total tour price minus \$800 for all destinations except Mexico, which is minus \$350. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

IMPORTANT NATIVITY PILGRIMAGE POLICIES

The airline selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

Single Room: Tour price is based on double occupancy. If you'd like a single room, there is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Seat Upgrades: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Seat Location Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Other Special Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a special request, such as a wheelchair, food, etc., we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily)

BOOKING CONDITIONS

Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

Payment Deadline: 50% of the trip cost is due 03/31/2026 (100 Days before departure). The remaining 50% is due 05/11/2026 (60 days before departure). Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

Payment Methods: We accept major credit cards, checks, money orders, Zelle payments (accounting@nativitypilgrimage.com), and ACH transactions. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction.

LATE PAYMENT POLICY

Customers will receive Late Fees if they are not paid in full:

PRIOR TO DEPARTURE	FEE
100 - 61 days	\$150
60 - 30 days	\$300
30 days - day before departure	subject to cancellation

Customers are also responsible for any difference in fare due to late payment (subject to availability). Refusal to pay will be considered a cancellation.

CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY

Full Refund Policy for Holy Land (War-Related Cancellations Only): If war occurs and the airline cancels flights to the Holy Land, Nativity Pilgrimage will issue a full refund for the land portion if canceled within 50 days of departure. For cancellations less than 50 days of departure, if airline tickets have been issued, the airline's refund and cancellation policies will apply to the airfare portion.

Multi-Country Pilgrimages (Holy Land + Other Destinations): If the itinerary includes Jordan, Egypt, Rome, Greece, or other destinations, the refund policies of the respective local travel providers will apply to those portions.

Airline Ticket Terms: Once tickets are issued, all airline terms and conditions apply, including penalties, refunds, and rebooking policies.

PROTECT YOUR TRIP

Every pilgrim traveling with Nativity will receive complimentary medical insurance that provides coverage for the full duration of your trip.

We also strongly recommend purchasing trip cancellation insurance (available at an additional cost) to safeguard your travel investment in case unforeseen circumstances require you to cancel. Please contact our office for details about trip cancellation insurance options.

Important: If you plan to purchase Cancel for Any Reason (CFAR) coverage, it must be purchased at the time of registration.
