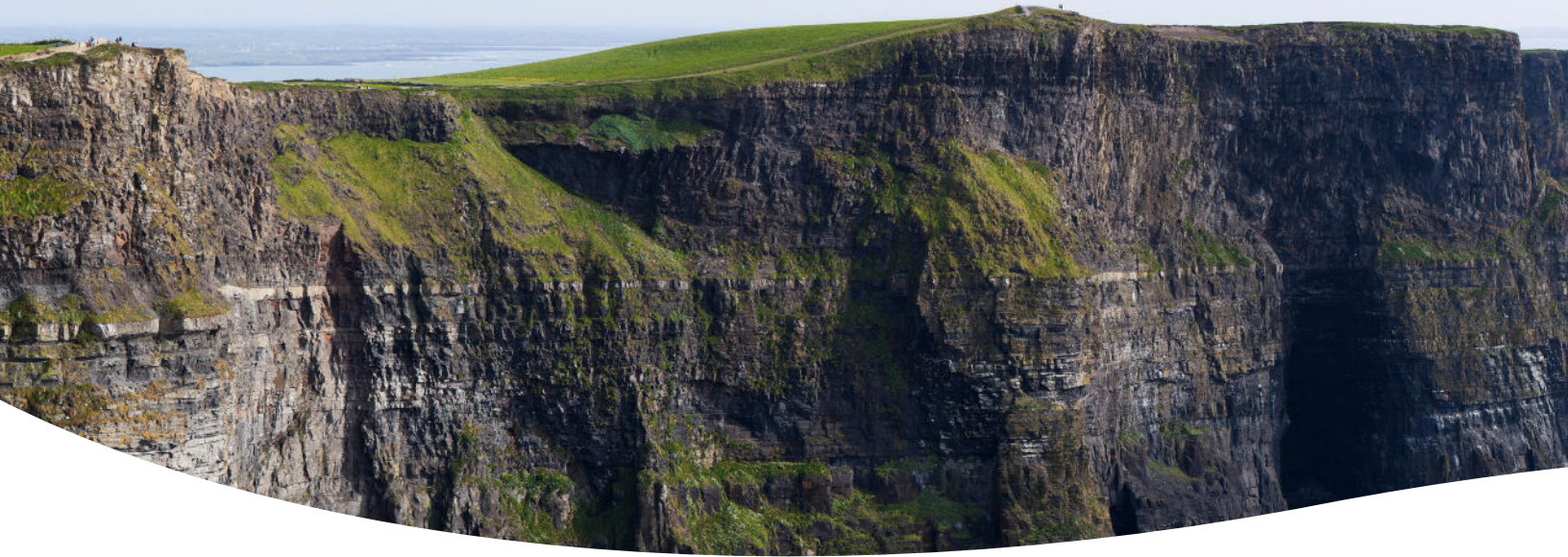

DAY 1: DEPART FOR DUBLIN

Your exciting journey begins today as you board your international flight bound for Dublin via London. Settle in, relax, and enjoy the meals and beverages provided onboard as you begin this unforgettable pilgrimage through Ireland's rich spiritual heritage.

DAY 2: ARRIVAL & THE HEART OF DUBLIN

Upon arrival in Dublin, you will be met by your local guide and driver. Begin exploring the spiritual heart of the city with visits to Christ Church Cathedral, founded in 1030, and St. Patrick's Cathedral, Ireland's largest church and a symbol of the nation's Christian faith. This evening, enjoy a welcoming dinner at your hotel, followed by a restful overnight stay in Dublin.

DAY 3: THE FIRE OF SLANE & THE HIGH KINGS

This morning, travel to the Hill of Slane, where St. Patrick famously lit the Paschal Fire in defiance of the pagan High King, marking a pivotal moment in Ireland's Christian history. Continue to the Hill of Tara, the ancient spiritual and political seat of the High Kings of Ireland. Return to Dublin for dinner and overnight.

DAY 4: GLENDALOUGH / KILDARE

Begin the day at Glendalough, one of Ireland's most important early monastic settlements, founded by St. Kevin amid stunning natural scenery. In the afternoon, visit Kildare, the

site of St. Brigid's monastery and a center of early Christian learning. Travel onward to Kilkenny for dinner and overnight.

DAY 5: KILKENNY / THE GRAVE OF ST. DECLAN

In Kilkenny, visit the Black Abbey, renowned for its striking 14th-century stained glass windows. Later, journey south to the Waterford coast and the village of Ardmore, home to the grave of St. Declan, one of Ireland's earliest saints. Visit his oratory and the ancient round tower, a Christian site that predates St. Patrick. Continue to Cork for dinner and overnight.

DAY 6: THE ROCK OF CASHEL / KILLARNEY

Today features one of Ireland's most iconic landmarks, the Rock of Cashel, where you will explore the cathedral and the beautifully preserved Romanesque Cormac's Chapel. In the afternoon, enjoy a scenic drive into the lush landscapes of the Kingdom of Kerry, arriving in Killarney for dinner and overnight.

DAY 7: THE DINGLE PENINSULA / RIASC

Experience the breathtaking beauty of the Sleat Head Drive along the Dingle Peninsula, offering dramatic coastal views. Visit the early monastic settlement of Riasc, known for its ancient pillar stones, and continue to the Gallarus Oratory, a remarkably preserved dry-stone church dating from the 6th-

9th century. Return to Killarney for dinner and overnight.

DAY 8: THE CLIFFS OF MOHER / GALWAY

Travel north to the spectacular Cliffs of Moher, where a boat tour along the Atlantic reveals the dramatic scale of these towering sea cliffs. In the evening, arrive in Galway City, where the group will have dedicated time to explore, shop for local crafts, and enjoy the lively atmosphere. Dinner and overnight in Galway.

DAY 9: CLONMACNOISE / THE SHANNON

Journey to the heart of Ireland to visit Clonmacnoise, one of the country's most important early Christian centers and often referred to as the "University of Europe" in the 6th century. Focus on the magnificent High Crosses and the burial sites of Irish kings. Continue to Knock for dinner and overnight.

DAY 10: SHRINE OF OUR LADY OF KNOCK

Enjoy a full, unhurried day of prayer and reflection at the Shrine of Our Lady of Knock. Visit the Apparition Chapel, the Basilica, and the museum dedicated to this sacred Marian site. Dinner and overnight in Donegal.

DAY 11: LOUGH DERG & CENTRAL IRELAND

Take a guided tour of Lough Derg, including visits to ancient artifacts, historic buildings, and exclusive artwork such as

stained-glass windows by renowned Irish artist Harry Clarke. Travel onward to central Ireland for dinner and overnight near Mullingar or Athlone.

DAY 12: THE MARTYR OF DROGHEDA & FAREWELL

This morning, visit Drogheda and St. Peter's Church to venerate the relics of St. Oliver Plunkett, the last Catholic martyr of Ireland and England. His witness provides a profound spiritual conclusion to the pilgrimage. Return to Dublin in the afternoon for a festive farewell dinner. Dinner and overnight in Dublin.

DAY 13: RETURN FLIGHT HOME

Transfer to Dublin Airport for your return flight to the United States, carrying with you the memories, faith, and inspiration of this remarkable pilgrimage.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

YOUR PACKAGE INCLUDES

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

Land Transportation: All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotels: Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Meal Plan: The meal plan offers breakfast & dinner daily, unless otherwise stated.

Baggage: Most airlines limit passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions.

Airport Fees: Airport Taxes, Portage, Fuel Surcharges and Security Fees

Medical Insurance: Medical coverage for the duration of your trip.

YOUR PACKAGE DOES NOT INCLUDE

Cancellation Insurance: We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

Passport Expenses: This includes any passports or additional travel documents that may be required. Passports must be valid until at least 6 months from your return date.

Personal Expenses: Laundry, beverages (including wine, liquor, mineral water, tea, coffee, etc.), meals or food items not listed on the included menu plan, and any excess or additional luggage.

Non-itinerary fees: Any sightseeing or service fees or personal items that are not specifically mentioned as being included in the itinerary.

Non-included meals: You are responsible for any meals not specified in your itinerary.

Tips/Gratuities: This includes tour guides, drivers, hotel service staff, and wait staff.

GENERAL TRAVEL INFORMATION

Group Air: Group Air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different air rate, ticketing method, or on a different airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

Departure Cities: If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule in order to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the "Land Only" option. This amount equals to the total tour price minus \$800 for all destinations except Mexico, which is minus \$350. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

IMPORTANT POLICIES

The airline selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

Single Room: Tour price is based on double occupancy. If you'd like a single room, there is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Seat Upgrades: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade or seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Other Special Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a special request, such as a wheelchair, food, etc., we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

BOOKING CONDITIONS

Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due 2/6/2026 100 Days before departure. Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

Payment Methods: We accept major credit cards, checks, money orders, and Zelle payments. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction.

LATE PAYMENT POLICY

Customers will receive Late Fees if they are not paid in full:

PRIOR TO DEPARTURE	FEE
100 - 61 days	\$150
60 - 30 days	\$300
30 days - day before departure	subject to cancellation

Customers are also responsible for any difference in fare due to late payment (subject to availability). Refusal to pay will be considered a cancellation.

CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY

We hope that nothing will prevent you from taking your pilgrimage with Nativity Pilgrimage, however, should you need to cancel your trip, your cancellation must be in writing via email or letter. It will be effective on the date of receipt. The following cancellation fees will apply:

PRIOR TO DEPARTURE	PENALTY
100 + days	Lose deposit
99 - 50 days	50% of trip cost
49 days or less	100% of trip cost

Insurance premiums are non-refundable. We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance to avoid these cancellation fees.

PROTECT YOUR TRIP

Every pilgrim traveling with Nativity will receive complimentary medical insurance that provides coverage for the full duration of your trip.

We also strongly recommend purchasing trip cancellation insurance (available at an additional cost) to safeguard your travel investment in case unforeseen circumstances require you to cancel. Please contact our office for details about trip cancellation insurance options.

Important: If you plan to purchase Cancel for Any Reason (CFAR) coverage, it must be purchased at the time of registration.
