DAY 1: DEPARTURE TO TEL AVIV, ISRAEL

Today an extraordinary pilgrimage begins as you board your flight to the beautiful land of Israel. Prepare for a truly transformative spiritual experience as you follow in the footsteps of Jesus and explore the rich tapestry of faith and history.

DAY 2: TEL AVIV / NETANYA

Upon arrival at Ben Gurion Airport, you will pass smoothly through customs and begin this incredible journey with our friendly guide, who will accompany you every step of the way. You will then board our comfortable motor coach for a scenic drive to your hotel in Netanya. If time permits, we will stop in the historic city of Jaffa to celebrate a special Mass at the Church of St. Peter. After a rewarding day, relax and enjoy dinner at your hotel in Netanya, where you will overnight.

DAY 3: CAESAREA MARITIMA / MUHRAQA / MT. CARMEL / HAIFA / TIBERIAS

Our day begins at the impressive ruins of Caesarea Maritima, home to the ancient palace of Herod. We then celebrate Mass at Deir Al-Muhraqa, standing on the very site where Elijah confronted the prophets of Baal and Asherah (1 Kings 18). Our next stop is the serene Stella Maris Monastery on Mount Carmel, followed by a visit to the beautiful city of Haifa. The day concludes as we travel to the charming city of Tiberias for dinner and overnight at your hotel.

DAY 4: CANA / NAZARETH / MOUNT TABOR / TIBERIAS

We begin in Cana, where Jesus performed His first miracle. At the Wedding Church, couples are invited to renew their marriage vows and receive a special certificate commemorating their love. We then explore Nazareth, visiting the Basilica of the Annunciation, the Church of St. Joseph, Mary's Well, and the lively Old Market. Afterward, we ascend Mount Tabor, the site of the Transfiguration, before returning to the comfort of Tiberias for dinner and overnight.

DAY 5: MOUNT OF BEATITUDES / TABGHA / CAPERNAUM / SEA OF GALILEE / BETHLEHEM

The day begins at the peaceful Mount of Beatitudes, where Jesus delivered His profound Sermon on the Mount. We continue to Tabgha, site of the miracle of the Feeding of the Five Thousand, and visit the Church of the Primacy of Peter, commemorating the Miraculous Catch of Fish. Next, we explore Capernaum, where Jesus lived and began His ministry. In the afternoon, enjoy a unique experience: celebrating Mass aboard a boat on the beautiful Sea of Galilee, capturing the spirit of Jesus' time. We then travel to Bethlehem for dinner and overnight.

DAY 6: BETHLEHEM / CHURCH OF THE NATIVITY / SHEPHERDS' FIELD / EIN KAREM

We begin the day by celebrating Mass at the serene Shepherds' Field, rich in history and significance. We then visit the magnificent Church of the Nativity, built over the very place where Jesus was

born. In the afternoon, we travel to Ein Karem, the birthplace of St. John the Baptist. There we visit the Church of the Visitation, where the Virgin Mary proclaimed her beautiful hymn of praise, the Magnificat, to her cousin Elizabeth. Dinner and overnight in Bethlehem.

DAY 7: BETHANY / JORDAN RIVER / JERICHO / QUMRAN / DEAD SEA

After breakfast, we travel to Bethany to visit the church dedicated to Lazarus, then continue to the peaceful Jordan River to renew our baptismal promises. We stop in Jericho, the oldest city in the world, where we celebrate Mass. We then visit the Mount of Temptation, where Jesus fasted, and Qumran, home of the Dead Sea Scrolls. Finally, enjoy time floating in the mineral-rich waters of the Dead Sea before returning to Bethlehem for dinner and overnight.

DAY 8: JERUSALEM: PALM SUNDAY ROUTE

Today we explore Jerusalem, beginning on the Mount of Olives and visiting the site of the Lord's Prayer. We walk along the Palm Sunday route, stopping at Dominus Flevit, where Jesus wept over the city. At the Garden of Gethsemane, we reflect at the Rock of Agony before celebrating Mass at the Church of All Nations. We then visit the Chapel of the Ascension. In the afternoon, we travel to Mount Zion to

visit the Upper Room (Cenacle) and conclude the day at St. Peter in Gallicantu, where Peter denied Jesus. Return to Bethlehem for dinner and overnight.

DAY 9: JERUSALEM: VIA DOLOROSA

Our day begins with a reflective walk along the Via Dolorosa, retracing the final steps of Jesus through the Old City. We meditate on each Station of the Cross before arriving at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, Christianity's most sacred site, where Jesus was crucified and buried. After celebrating Mass, we visit the Church of St. Anne, traditionally the home of the Virgin Mary. Passing by the Ecce Homo, where Pontius Pilate proclaimed, "Behold the Man," we pause in reverence. The pilgrimage concludes at the Western Wall, the holiest site in Judaism. The remainder of the day is free for personal exploration or reflection. We gather for a farewell dinner at a local restaurant before overnight in Bethlehem.

DAY 10: RETURN FLIGHT HOME

This morning we transfer to the airport for our return flight home, carrying with us the rich experiences and lasting memories of this spiritually enriching pilgrimage.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

YOUR PACKAGE INCLUDES

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

Land Transportation: All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotels: Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Meal Plan: The meal plan offers breakfast & dinner daily, unless otherwise stated.

Baggage: Most airlines limit all passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions.

Airport Fees: Airport Taxes, Portage, Fuel Surcharges and Security Fees

Medical Insurance: Coverage for the duration of your trip.

YOUR PACKAGE DOES NOT INCLUDE

Cancellation Insurance: We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

Passport Expenses: This includes any passports or additional travel documents that may be required. Passports must be valid until at least 6 months from your return date.

Personal Expenses: Laundry, beverages (including wine, liquor, mineral water, tea, coffee, etc.), meals or food items not listed on the included menu plan, and any excess or additional luggage.

Non-itinerary fees: Any sightseeing or service fees or personal items that are not specifically mentioned as being included in the itinerary.

Non-included meals: You are responsible for any meals not specified in your itinerary.

Tips/Gratuities: This includes tour guides, drivers, hotel service staff, and wait staff.

GENERAL TRAVEL INFORMATION

Group Air: Group Air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different air rate, ticketing method, or on a different airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

Departure Cities: If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule in order to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the "Land Only" option. This amount equals to the total tour price minus \$800 for all destinations except Mexico, which is minus \$350. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

IMPORTANT NATIVITY PILGRIMAGE POLICIES

The airline selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

Single Room: Tour price is based on double occupancy. If you'd like a single room, there is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Seat Upgrades: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Seat Location Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Other Special Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a special request, such as a wheelchair, food, etc., we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

BOOKING CONDITIONS

Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due 5/8/2026 100 Days before departure. Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

Payment Methods: We accept major credit cards, checks, money orders, Zelle payments (accounting@nativitypilgrimage.com), and ACH transactions. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction.

LATE PAYMENT POLICY

Customers will receive Late Fees if they are not paid in full:

Customers are also responsible for any difference in fare due to late payment (subject to availability). Refusal to pay will be considered a cancellation.

CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY

Full Refund Policy for Holy Land (War-Related Cancellations Only): If war occurs and the airline cancels flights to the Holy Land, Nativity Pilgrimage will issue a full refund for the land portion if canceled within 50 days of departure. For cancellations less than 50 days of departure, if airline tickets have been issued, the airline's refund and cancellation policies will apply to the airfare portion.

Multi-Country Pilgrimages (Holy Land + Other Destinations): If the itinerary includes Jordan, Egypt, Rome, Greece, or other destinations, the refund policies of the respective local travel providers will apply to those portions.

Airline Ticket Terms: Once tickets are issued, all airline terms and conditions apply, including penalties, refunds, and rebooking policies.

Every pilgrim traveling with Nativity will receive complimentary medical insurance that provides coverage for the full duration of your trip.
