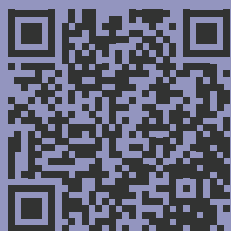

DAY 1: DEPART FOR WARSAW

Begin your pilgrimage with an overnight flight to Warsaw, Poland, preparing for a remarkable journey of faith, history, and spiritual discovery.

DAY 2: WARSAW

Arrive in Warsaw, meet your local guide, and transfer to your hotel. Enjoy dinner and overnight accommodations as you prepare for the journey ahead.

DAY 3: NIEPOKALANÓW / GŁOGOWIEC / CZESTOCHOWA

Visit Niepokalanów, home of St. Maximilian Kolbe, then continue to Głogowiec, birthplace of St. Faustina. Travel to Jasna Góra Monastery in Czestochowa to venerate the Black Madonna, Poland's beloved Marian icon.

DAY 4: CZESTOCHOWA / AUSCHWITZ / WADOWICE / KRAKOW

Visit Auschwitz and reflect on the witness of St. Maximilian Kolbe. Continue to Wadowice, birthplace of Pope St. John Paul II, before traveling to Krakow for dinner and overnight.

DAY 5: KRAKOW / DIVINE MERCY SHRINE

Tour Krakow, including Market Square, Wawel Royal Castle, St. Mary's Church, and the historic university. In the afternoon, visit the Divine Mercy Shrine in Łagiewniki and celebrate Mass at the Chapel of Relics.

DAY 6: KRAKOW / WIELICZKA / PRAGUE

Visit the remarkable Wieliczka Salt Mines, including chapels and chambers carved from salt. Continue to Prague, the "Golden City," for dinner and overnight.

DAY 7: PRAGUE

Explore Prague's sacred and historic landmarks, including Strahov Monastery, the Loreto Shrine, Prague Castle, St. Vitus Cathedral, St. George Basilica, Golden Lane, St. Nicholas Church, and Charles Bridge. Celebrate Mass at the Church of Our Lady of Victory.

DAY 8: PRAGUE / MELK / VIENNA

Travel to Austria with a stop at Melk Abbey, renowned for its gardens, marble hall, library, and Baroque beauty. Continue to Vienna for dinner and overnight.

DAY 9: VIENNA

Tour Vienna's highlights, including the Vienna Opera House, St. Augustine's Church, St. Stephen's Cathedral, Mozart's House, Heroes' Square, Hofburg Palace, and the Naschmarkt. Enjoy free time, with the option to visit Schönbrunn Palace.

DAY 10: VIENNA / ZAGREB

Enjoy a scenic drive to Zagreb, Croatia. Upon arrival, visit the Cathedral of Zagreb before dinner and overnight.

DAY 11: ZAGREB / KARLOVAC / PLITVICE LAKES / SPLIT

Travel toward Split with stops in Karlovac to visit the Church of the Holy Trinity and Franciscan Monastery, followed by the natural beauty of Plitvice Lakes. Continue to Split for dinner and overnight.

DAY 12: SPLIT / MEDJUGORJE

Tour Split, including Diocletian's Palace, the Temple of Jupiter, and the Cathedral of St. Domnius. Celebrate Mass at a local church before continuing to Medjugorje.

DAY 13: MEDJUGORJE

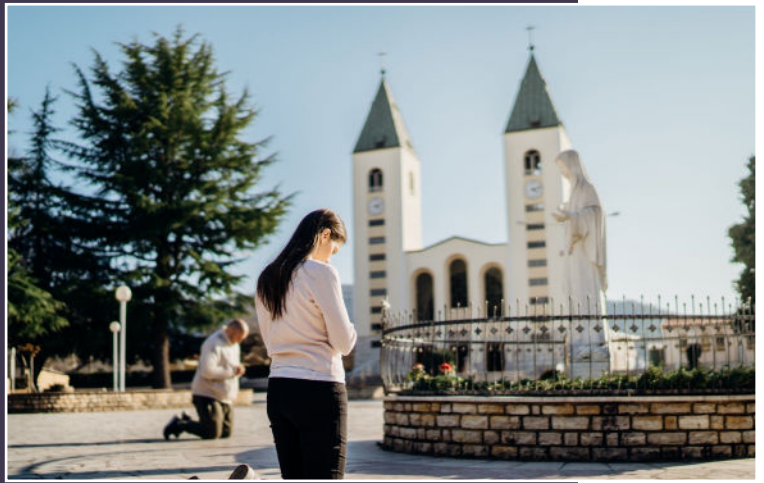
Spend the day in prayer and reflection. Celebrate Mass, climb Apparition Hill, pray the rosary with fellow pilgrims, and enjoy time for personal devotion and exploration.

DAY 14: MEDJUGORJE / DUBROVNIK

Travel to Dubrovnik, the "Pearl of the Adriatic." Enjoy a walking tour of the Old Town, including St. Blasius Church, Rector's Palace, Sponza Palace, the Cathedral of the Assumption, and the Dominican and Franciscan Monasteries. Gather for a farewell dinner.

DAY 15: RETURN HOME

Transfer to the airport for your return flight home, carrying lasting memories and spiritual blessings from this pilgrimage through Central Europe, Croatia, and Medjugorje.

Travel Considerations



We strongly recommend purchasing "Cancel For Any Reason" travel insurance to protect your investment upon any unforeseen circumstances. We offer coverage or you are free to purchase from your own insurance carrier.

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This pilgrimage itinerary may include early mornings, full sightseeing days, extended travel times, multiple modes of transportation, and moderate physical activity. Please review the full itinerary for complete details.

YOUR PACKAGE INCLUDES

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

Land Transportation: All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotels: Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Meal Plan: The meal plan offers breakfast & dinner daily, unless otherwise stated.

Baggage: Most airlines limit passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions.

Airport Fees: Airport Taxes, Portage, Fuel Surcharges and Security Fees

Medical Insurance: Medical coverage for the duration of your trip.

Tips/Gratuities: This includes tour guides, drivers, hotel service staff, and wait staff.

YOUR PACKAGE DOES NOT INCLUDE

Cancellation Insurance: We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

Passport Expenses: This includes any passports or additional travel documents that may be required. Passports must be valid until at least 6 months from your return date.

Personal Expenses: Laundry, beverages (including wine, liquor, mineral water, tea, coffee, etc.), meals or food items not listed on the included menu plan, and any excess or additional luggage.

Non-itinerary fees: Any sightseeing or service fees or personal items that are not specifically mentioned as being included in the itinerary.

Non-included meals: You are responsible for any meals not specified in your itinerary.

GENERAL TRAVEL INFORMATION

Group Air: Group Air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different air rate, ticketing method, or on a different airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

Departure Cities: If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule in order to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the "Land Only" option. This amount equals to the total tour price minus \$800 for all destinations except Mexico, which is minus \$350. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

IMPORTANT POLICIES

The airline selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

Single Room: Tour price is based on double occupancy. If you'd like a single room, there is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Seat Upgrades: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade or seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Other Special Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a special request, such as a wheelchair, food, etc., we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

BOOKING CONDITIONS

Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due Monday, Dec. 21, 2026. Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

Payment Methods: We accept major credit cards, checks, money orders, and Zelle payments. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction.

LATE PAYMENT POLICY

Customers will receive Late Fees if they are not paid in full:

Customers are also responsible for any difference in fare due to late payment (subject to availability). Refusal to pay will be considered a cancellation.

CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY

We hope that nothing will prevent you from taking your pilgrimage with Nativity Pilgrimage, however, should you need to cancel your trip, your cancellation must be in writing via email or letter. It will be effective on the date of receipt. The following cancellation fees will apply:

49 days or less	100% of trip cost
