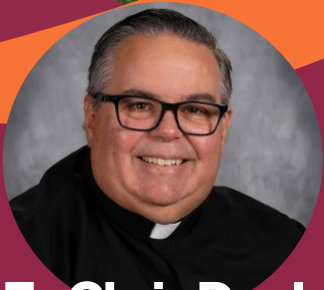

# Itinerary

## DAY 1: DEPART FOR GREECE

(Sept. 7th) Your pilgrimage begins today as you depart on your overnight flight to Greece. Sit back, relax, and enjoy your flight. Your spiritual journey awaits!

## DAY 2: ARRIVE IN THESSALONIKI

(Sept. 8th) Upon arrival at the Thessaloniki airport, our professional tour guide will warmly welcome you before you board our motorcoach. Settle in as we make our way to our hotel for a splendid dinner and overnight stay at our hotel in Thessaloniki.

## DAY 3: KAVALA | PHILIPPI | THESSALONIKI

(Sept. 9th) After breakfast, our day begins as we travel to Kavala, which was once the ancient port of Neapolis (Acts 16: 9-11). This is where St. Paul, Silas, Luke and Timothy landed when they reached Europe. We will then drive to Philippi, where St. Paul baptized a woman named Lydia, the first convert to Christianity in Europe, in a nearby river (Acts 16:11-15). Mass will be celebrated. We will also see where St. Paul preached his first sermon and established the first church in Europe. While imprisoned in Rome, St. Paul wrote one of his epistles to the Philippians (Acts 16: 11-40). As the day draws to a close, we will return to Thessaloniki for dinner and a restful overnight stay at our hotel.

## DAY 4: THESSALONIKI | VERIA | KALAMBAKA

(Sept. 10th) After breakfast and hotel check-out, we will embark on a scenic drive to Veria (ancient Berea) to visit the monument known as "Apostle Paul's Podium", the steps where Paul stood and preached. Mass will be celebrated. We will continue our drive to Kalambaka where we will get settled into our hotel which has fantastic views of the dramatic Meteora cliffs. Enjoy time to unwind before our delightful dinner, a night of song and praise, and peaceful overnight at our hotel in Kalambaka.

## DAY 5: METEORA | KALAMBAKA

(Sept. 11th) After breakfast, our day begins with a visit to two Meteora monasteries, a unique UNESCO World Heritage Site. These incredible monasteries are built upon immense boulders that dominate the area. We will gaze upon stunning Byzantine art and breathtaking landscapes. Next, we will learn about icons and have the opportunity to shop at a local artisan workshop. Mass will be celebrated. Enjoy dinner before retiring for a restful overnight stay at our hotel in Kalambaka.

## DAY 6: KALAMBAKA | ATHENS

(Sept. 12th) After breakfast and hotel check-out, we will journey to Athens, the oldest and one of the most glorious cities in the world. Mass will be celebrated. Then, we will ascend Mars Hill where St. Paul spoke to the Athenians about the one, true God (Acts 17:22). We will also visit the Acropolis (rock) where we will see the ruins of the Parthenon. As the day draws to a close, we will gather for a delightful dinner and peaceful overnight stay at our hotel in Athens.

## DAY 7: ICONIC GREEK ISLANDS CRUISE | MYKONOS

(Sept. 13th) After breakfast and hotel check-out, we will travel by bus to the port of Lavrio and embark on an iconic cruise through the Greek islands. After setting sail, we will gather for Mass onboard the ship. We will enjoy the gorgeous scenery of pristine beaches and blue ocean waters as we make our way to Mykonos, a

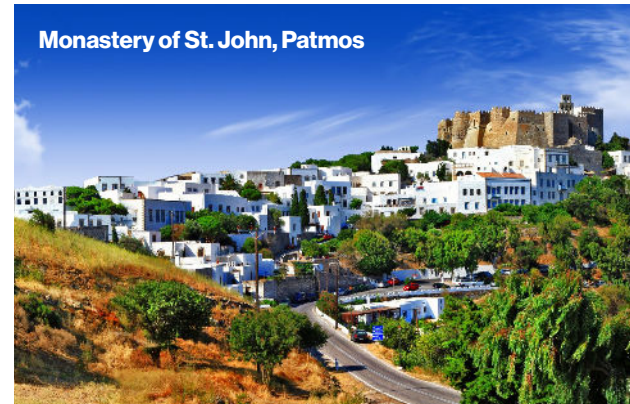

charming island filled with family-owned restaurants, boutiques, and old-world appeal. Enjoy dinner on your own in Mykonos or abroad on the ship. Return to the cruise ship for a restful overnight.

### DAY 8: KUSADASI | PATMOS

(Sept. 14th) After breakfast, we disembark in Kusadasi and begin our excursion through western Turkey. We visit the House of the Virgin Mary at Mt. Koresos, where tradition holds that she spent her final years. Mass will be celebrated. We then continue to the ancient city of Ephesus, walking from the Great Theatre, once seating 24,000 spectators, along the Arcadian Way to the harbor. Along the route, there will be an opportunity to support local artisans known for traditional rug-making. Lunch is served onboard as we sail to Patmos. Upon arrival at Skala Harbor, we visit the Monastery of St. John the Theologian and the Cave of the Apocalypse, where St. John is believed to have received the visions recorded in the Book of Revelation. We return to the ship for dinner and overnight accommodations.

### DAY 9: RHODES

(Sept. 15th) After breakfast, we will enjoy our day on the beautiful island of Rhodes where beautiful beaches, castles and ancient civilizations effortlessly mix with traditional cuisine and countless shops. Enjoy wandering through the medieval city and lunch on your own. We will gather for Mass at Our Lady of Victory in Rhodes. We will then retreat to the ship for a delightful dinner, a night of song and worship, and restful overnight.

### DAY 10: CRETE | SANTORINI

(Sept. 16th) After breakfast, we visit Heraklion, where St. Paul is believed to have warned the ship's captain and crew about continuing their voyage to Rome. We visit the Church of St. Titus, a disciple of St. Paul and the first bishop of Crete, and celebrate Mass at a local Catholic church. We then sail to Santorini, renowned for its dramatic volcanic landscape and breathtaking caldera views. Enjoy free time to explore and savor the island's distinctive cuisine before returning to the ship for dinner and an overnight stay.

### DAY 11: ATHENS | CORINTH

(Sept. 17th) After breakfast and disembarkation at Lavrio, we travel to ancient Corinth, where St. Paul spent nearly two years preaching the Gospel and working alongside Aquila and Priscilla (Acts 18:1-18). In Corinth, we reflect on St. Paul's letters to the early Christian community and celebrate Mass together, offering our final prayers of thanksgiving for the graces received throughout our pilgrimage. This evening, we gather for a farewell dinner at a local restaurant, sharing memories and fellowship before retiring for our final overnight stay in Athens.

### DAY 12: RETURN HOME

(Sept. 18th) We will depart Athens for our return flight home.

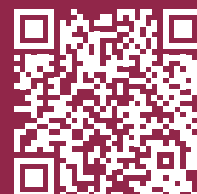

## YOUR PACKAGE INCLUDES

**Air Transportation:** Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used toward future travel.

**Land Transportation:** All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

**Hotels:** Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator is responsible for providing a roommate.

**Cruise:** Full board on cruise ship includes standard inside IB rooms (room upgrades based on availability for an additional charge)

**Meal Plan:** The meal plan offers breakfast & dinner daily, unless otherwise stated.

**Baggage:** Most airlines limit passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airline carriers for up-to-date baggage weight and dimension requirements.

**Tips/Gratuities:** This includes tour guides, drivers, hotel service staff, and wait staff.

**Airport Fees:** Airport taxes, portorage, fuel surcharges, and security fees

**Medical Insurance:** Medical coverage for the duration of your trip.

## YOUR PACKAGE DOES NOT INCLUDE

**Cancellation Insurance:** We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

**Passport Expenses:** This includes any passports or additional travel documents that may be required. Passports must be valid until at least 6 months from your return date.

**Personal Expenses:** Laundry, beverages (including wine, liquor, mineral water, tea, coffee, etc.), meals or food items not listed on the included menu plan, and any excess or additional luggage.

**Non-itinerary fees:** Any sightseeing or service fees or personal items that are not specifically mentioned as being included in the itinerary.

**Non-included meals:** You are responsible for any meals not specified in your itinerary.

## GENERAL TRAVEL INFORMATION

**Group Air:** Group Air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different air rate, ticketing method, or on a different airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

**Departure Cities:** If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule in order to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

**Land-Only Option:** If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the "Land Only" option. This amount equals the total tour price minus \$800 for all destinations except Mexico, which is minus \$350. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

## IMPORTANT POLICIES

The airline selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

**Single Room:** Tour price is based on double occupancy. If you'd like a single room, there is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis.

**Seat Upgrades:** Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade or seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

**Other Special Requests:** Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a special request, such as wheelchair assistance, meal requests, etc., we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

## BOOKING CONDITIONS

**Deposit:** A non-refundable deposit of \$800.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

**Payment Deadline:** Full payment is due (05/10/2027) 120 days before departure. Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

**Payment Methods:** We accept major credit cards, checks, money orders, and Zelle payments. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction.

## LATE PAYMENT POLICY

Customers will receive late fees if they are not paid in full:

PRIOR TO DEPARTURE	FEE
120 - 61 days	\$150
60 - 30 days	\$300
30 days - day before departure	subject to cancellation

Customers are also responsible for any difference in fare due to late payment (subject to availability). Refusal to pay will be considered a cancellation.

## CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY

We hope that nothing will prevent you from taking your pilgrimage with Nativity Pilgrimage, however, should you need to cancel your trip, your cancellation must be in writing via email or letter. It will be effective on the date of receipt. The following cancellation fees will apply:

PRIOR TO DEPARTURE	PENALTY
120 + days	Loss of deposit
119 - 50 days	50% of trip cost
49 days or less	100% of trip cost

Insurance premiums are non-refundable. We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance to avoid these cancellation fees.

## PROTECT YOUR TRIP

**Medical Insurance:** Every pilgrim traveling with Nativity will receive complimentary medical insurance that provides coverage for the full duration of your trip.

**Trip Cancellation Insurance:** We also strongly recommend purchasing trip cancellation insurance (available at an additional cost) to safeguard your travel investment in case unforeseen circumstances require you to cancel.
