DAY 1: DEPARTURE – FLIGHT TO ROME

Depart for Rome, where your pilgrimage of faith, beauty, and sacred tradition begins. As you journey overnight, prepare your heart and mind for the spiritual encounters that await.

DAY 2: ARRIVE IN ROME

Benvenuti a Roma. Upon arrival, meet your private guide and enjoy a panoramic introduction to this timeless city, where ancient history and Christian heritage intertwine. Visit the iconic Trevi Fountain and take time for leisure before transferring to your hotel. This evening, gather for a welcome dinner, marking the beginning of your shared pilgrimage.

DAY 3: PAPAL AUDIENCE & VATICAN CITY

Experience a profound highlight of your journey with a Papal Audience in St. Peter's Square with Pope Leo XIV! Enter St. Peter's Basilica, the heart of the Catholic Church, where you will encounter Michelangelo's Pietà and pray at the tomb of St. John Paul II. Continue through the Vatican Museums to the Sistine Chapel, where Michelangelo's masterpieces inspire awe and reflection. Conclude at the Basilica of St. Mary Major. Dinner and overnight in Rome.

DAY 4: CHRISTIAN ROME

Trace the footsteps of the early Church with visits to Rome's most sacred basilicas. Begin at St. John Lateran, followed by the Holy Stairs, traditionally believed to have been ascended by Christ during His Passion. Travel along the historic Appian Way, passing ancient ruins, and conclude at the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls, the final resting place of Paul the Apostle. Dinner will be at your hotel.

DAY 5: ANCIENT ROME | ASSISI

Discover the grandeur of Ancient Rome by visiting the Piazza Venezia, Capitoline Hill, the Pantheon, and the Mamertine Prison, where Peter and Paul were held. Walk along the Via dei Fori Imperiali with views of the Colosseum and Roman Forum. Afterward, visit the Basilica of St. Clement before departing for Assisi. Upon arrival, enjoy dinner and a peaceful evening in this serene hilltop town.

DAY 6: ASSISI – CITY OF ST. FRANCIS

Spend the day immersed in the spirit of St. Francis. Visit the Basilica of St. Francis and pray at his tomb, followed by the Church of St. Clare. Continue to the Basilica of St. Mary of the Angels, home to the Porziuncola, where the Franciscan movement began.

Enjoy time for quiet reflection before visiting the Santuario della Spogliazione, final resting place of Blessed Carlo Acutis. Dinner and overnight in Assisi.

DAY 7: LORETO | LANCIANO | SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO

Journey along the Adriatic coast to Loreto, where you will visit the Holy House of Nazareth, one of Christianity's most treasured Marian shrines. Continue to Lanciano to venerate the Eucharistic Miracle, a powerful testimony to the Real Presence. Proceed to San Giovanni Rotondo, home of St. Padre Pio, for dinner and overnight.

DAY 8: SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO | MONTE SANT'ANGELO

Spend time in prayer at the sanctuary of St. Padre Pio, visiting the crucifix associated with his stigmata and his confessional. Continue to Monte Sant'Angelo on the Gargano Peninsula to visit the sacred Grotto of St. Michael the Archangel, a place of pilgrimage for centuries. Return to San Giovanni Rotondo for dinner and overnight.

DAY 9: MONTE CASSINO | ROME

Travel through the Italian countryside to Monte Cassino, site of the great Benedictine Abbey founded by St. Benedict. Afterward, return to Rome. This evening, celebrate your pilgrimage with a farewell dinner, reflecting on the graces received throughout your journey.

DAY 10: RETURN HOME

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your return flight home, carrying with you the spiritual blessings, renewed faith, and cherished memories of your pilgrimage.

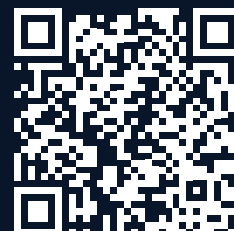

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YOUR PACKAGE INCLUDES

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

Land Transportation: All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotels: Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Meal Plan: The meal plan offers breakfast & dinner daily, unless otherwise stated.

Baggage: Most airlines limit passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airlines carriers for up to date baggage weight and dimensions.

Airport Fees: Airport Taxes, Portage, Fuel Surcharges and Security Fees

Medical Insurance: Medical coverage for the duration of your trip.

YOUR PACKAGE DOES NOT INCLUDE

Cancellation Insurance: We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

Passport Expenses: This includes any passports or additional travel documents that may be required. Passports must be valid until at least 6 months from your return date.

Personal Expenses: Laundry, beverages (including wine, liquor, mineral water, tea, coffee, etc.), meals or food items not listed on the included menu plan, and any excess or additional luggage.

Non-itinerary fees: Any sightseeing or service fees or personal items that are not specifically mentioned as being included in the itinerary.

Non-included meals: You are responsible for any meals not specified in your itinerary.

Tips/Gratuities: This includes tour guides, drivers, hotel service staff, and wait staff.

GENERAL TRAVEL INFORMATION

Group Air: Group Air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different air rate, ticketing method, or on a different airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

Departure Cities: If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule in order to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the 'Land Only' option. This amount equals to the total tour price minus \$800 for all destinations except Mexico, which is minus \$350. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

IMPORTANT POLICIES

The airline selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

Single Room: Tour price is based on double occupancy. If you'd like a single room, there is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Seat Upgrades: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade or seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Other Special Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a special request, such as a wheelchair, food, etc., we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

BOOKING CONDITIONS

Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due May 28, 2027. Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

Payment Methods: We accept major credit cards, checks, money orders, and Zelle payments. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction.

LATE PAYMENT POLICY

Customers will receive Late Fees if they are not paid in full:

100 - 61 days	\$150
60 - 30 days	\$300
30 days - day before departure	subject to cancellation

Customers are also responsible for any difference in fare due to late payment (subject to availability). Refusal to pay will be considered a cancellation.

CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY

We hope that nothing will prevent you from taking your pilgrimage with Nativity Pilgrimage, however, should you need to cancel your trip, your cancellation must be in writing via email or letter. It will be effective on the date of receipt. The following cancellation fees will apply:

PRIOR TO DEPARTURE	PENALTY
100 + days	Lose deposit
99 - 50 days	50% of trip cost
49 days or less	100% of trip cost

Insurance premiums are non-refundable. We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance to avoid these cancellation fees.
