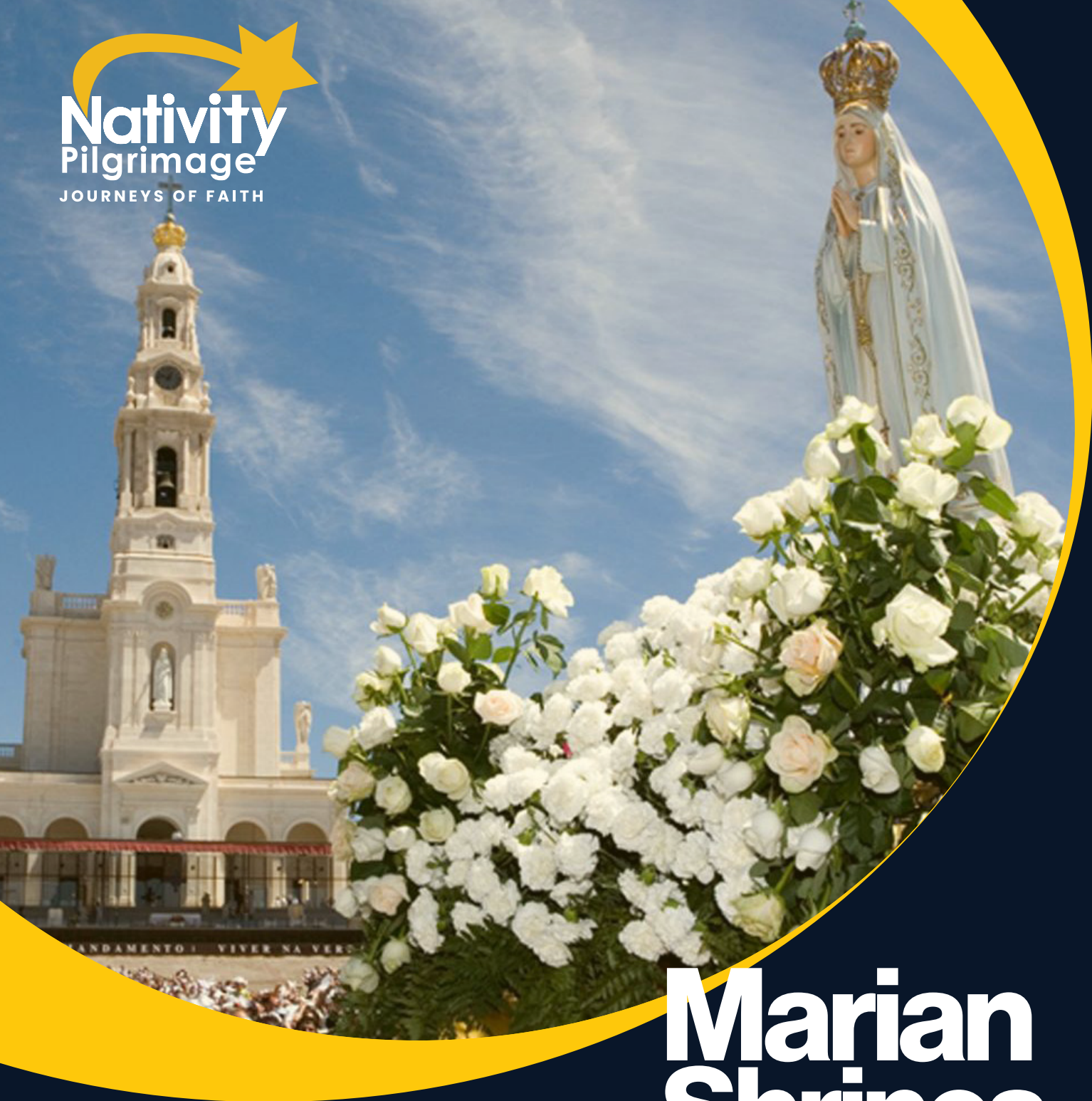

DAY 1 – DEPART FOR LISBON

Begin your pilgrimage with an overnight flight to Lisbon, preparing for a meaningful journey through some of Europe's most beloved Catholic shrines.

DAY 2: LISBON / SANTARÉM / FÁTIMA

Arrive in Lisbon and meet your local guide. Time permitting, visit Santarém and the Church of St. Stephen, known for its Eucharistic Miracle. Continue to Fátima for dinner and overnight.

DAY 3 – FÁTIMA

Celebrate Mass at the Chapel of Apparitions, then visit the Basilica of Our Lady of the Rosary. Continue to Aljustrel, the childhood village of the shepherd children, and Valinhos before praying the Stations of the Cross along the Via Sacra. Dinner and overnight in Fátima.

DAY 4: FÁTIMA / PORTO / SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA

Travel to Porto for a tour and tasting at a local wine cellar, followed by a visit to the Church of St. Francis. Continue to Santiago de Compostela for dinner and overnight.

DAY 5: SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA

Visit the Cathedral Basilica of Santiago de Compostela, burial place of St. James the Great. Continue to the Churches of San Francisco and Santa Clara, the Bell Tower, and other historic sites before dinner and overnight.

DAY 6: SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA / BURGOS

Travel to Burgos and visit its magnificent Gothic cathedral, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Celebrate Mass and enjoy time to explore the city before dinner and overnight.

DAY 7: BURGOS / LOYOLA / LOURDES

Visit Loyola, birthplace of St. Ignatius and home to the Basilica of Loyola. Continue to Lourdes for dinner and the evening Candlelight Procession.

DAY 8 – LOURDES

Visit St. Bernadette's home, the Basilica of the Immaculate Conception, the Miraculous Spring, the Shrine of Bernadette, the historic castle, and the Stations of the Cross. Enjoy time for personal prayer before dinner and overnight.

DAY 9: LOURDES / ROME

Fly to Rome and enjoy a panoramic tour of the Eternal City, including the Trevi Fountain, Pantheon, and Spanish Steps. Dinner and overnight in Rome.

DAY 10: ANCIENT ROME

Visit St. Paul Outside the Walls, then explore Ancient Rome, including the Colosseum, Capitoline Hill, Vittorio Emanuele Monument, Roman Forum, and Circus Maximus. Continue to St. Mary Major and St. John Lateran before dinner.

DAY 11: PAPAL AUDIENCE / VATICAN

Attend the Papal Audience in St. Peter's Square, subject to the Holy Father's schedule. Visit St. Peter's Basilica, celebrate Mass, and tour the Vatican Museums and Sistine Chapel before dinner and overnight.

DAY 12: ASSISI

Today, we'll visit the enchanting town of Assisi, home of Saint Francis. We'll start at the Basilica of St. Francis, reflecting at his tomb and exploring the chapel and the Church of St. Clare. Next, we'll head to the St. Mary of the Angels Basilica, stroll through medieval streets, and enjoy some free time for shopping and local cuisine. We'll also stop at the Santuario Della Spogliazione to honor St. Carlo Acutis' tomb. After a fulfilling day, we'll return to Rome for a farewell dinner before heading back to our hotel.

DAY 13: RETURN HOME

Transfer to the airport for your return flight home, carrying lasting memories from this remarkable pilgrimage through Portugal, Spain, France, and Italy.

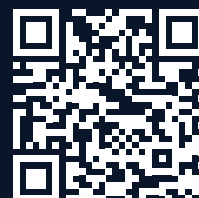

YOUR PACKAGE INCLUDES

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

Land Transportation: All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotels: Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Meal Plan: The meal plan offers breakfast & dinner daily, unless otherwise stated.

Baggage: Most airlines limit passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with the airline carriers for up-to-date baggage weight and dimensions.

Airport Fees: Airport Taxes, Portage, Fuel Surcharges and Security Fees

Medical Insurance: Medical coverage for the duration of your trip.

YOUR PACKAGE DOES NOT INCLUDE

Cancellation Insurance: We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

Passport Expenses: This includes any passports or additional travel documents that may be required. Passports must be valid until at least 6 months from your return date.

Personal Expenses: Laundry, beverages (including wine, liquor, mineral water, tea, coffee, etc.), meals or food items not listed on the included menu plan, and any excess or additional luggage.

Tips/Gratuities: This includes tour guides, drivers, hotel service staff, and wait staff.

Non-itinerary fees: Any sightseeing or service fees or personal items that are not specifically mentioned as being included in the itinerary.

Non-included meals: You are responsible for any meals not specified in your itinerary.

GENERAL TRAVEL INFORMATION

Group Air: Group Air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different air rate, ticketing method, or on a different airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

Departure Cities: If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule in order to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the "Land Only" option. This amount equals to the total tour price minus \$800 for all destinations except Mexico, which is minus \$350. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

IMPORTANT POLICIES

The airline selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

Single Room: Tour price is based on double occupancy. If you'd like a single room, there is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Seat Upgrades: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade or seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Other Special Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a special request, such as a wheelchair, food, etc., we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily)

BOOKING CONDITIONS

Deposit: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at the time of booking. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due 6/26/2026, 100 days before departure. Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

Payment Methods: We accept major credit cards, checks, money orders, and Zelle payments. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction.

LATE PAYMENT POLICY

Customers will receive Late fees if they are not paid in full:

PRIOR TO DEPARTURE	FEE
100 - 61 days	\$150
60 - 30 days	\$300
30 days - day before departure	subject to cancellation

Customers are also responsible for any difference in fare due to late payment (subject to availability). Refusal to pay will be considered a cancellation.

CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY

We hope that nothing will prevent you from taking your pilgrimage with Nativity Pilgrimage, however, should you need to cancel your trip, your cancellation must be in writing via email or letter. It will be effective on the date of receipt. The following cancellation fees will apply:

PRIOR TO DEPARTURE	PENALTY
100 + days	Lose deposit
99 - 50 days	50% of trip cost
49 days or less	100% of trip cost

Insurance premiums are non-refundable. We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance to avoid these cancellation fees.

PROTECT YOUR TRIP

Medical Insurance: Every pilgrim traveling with Nativity will receive complimentary medical insurance that provides coverage for the full duration of your trip.
