DAY 1: DEPART FOR TEL AVIV

Today marks the beginning of an extraordinary pilgrimage as you board your flight to the beautiful land of Israel. Get ready for a truly transformative spiritual experience as you walk in the footsteps of Jesus and explore the rich tapestry of faith and history.

DAY 2: TEL AVIV | NETANYA

Upon arriving at Ben Gurion Airport, you'll smoothly navigate customs and begin this unforgettable pilgrimage with our friendly guide, who will be with you every step. We'll then board our comfortable motor coach for the scenic drive to your hotel in Netanya. If time allows, we'll stop in the historic city of Jaffa to celebrate a special Mass at St. Peter's Church. After a fulfilling day, relax and enjoy dinner at your hotel in Netanya, where you'll spend the night.

DAY 3: CAESAREA MARITIMA | MOUNT CARMEL | HAIFA | TIBERIAS

Our day commences at the stunning ruins of Caesarea Maritima, home to Herod's ancient palace. Next, we'll celebrate Mass at Deir Al-Muhraqa, standing in the very place where Elijah confronted the Prophets of Baal and Asherah (1 Kings 18). The next stop is the serene Stella Maris Monastery on Mt. Carmel, followed by exploring the beautiful city of Haifa. Our journey will conclude as we drive to the enchanting Tiberias, where you can unwind and enjoy dinner at your hotel for the evening.

DAY 4: CANA | NAZARETH | MOUNT TABOR | TIBERIAS

We will begin at the joyful site of Cana, where Jesus performed His first miracle. At The Wedding Church of Cana, couples are invited to renew their wedding vows and receive a special certificate to commemorate their love. We will then explore Nazareth, visiting The Basilica of the Annunciation, St. Joseph's Church, Mary's Well, and the vibrant old market. Afterward, we'll ascend Mount Tabor, the site of the Transfiguration, before returning to the comforts of Tiberias for dinner and a restful night.

DAY 5: MOUNT OF BEATITUDES | TABGHA | CAPERNAUM | SEA OF GALILEE | BETHLEHEM

Today begins at the serene Mount of Beatitudes, where Jesus delivered His profound Sermon on the Mount. We'll then visit Tabgha, where the miracle of the "Feeding of the 5,000" took place, before seeing the Church of Peter's Primacy, where Jesus

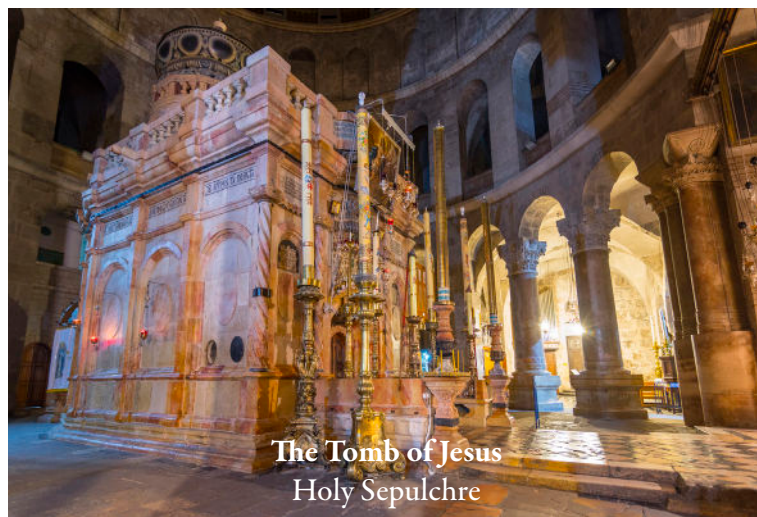

DAY 6: BETHLEHEM | NATIVITY CHURCH | SHEPHERD’S FIELD | EIN KAREM

We'll begin our day by celebrating Mass at the serene Shepherd's Field, a place rich with history and significance. Following this, we'll visit the magnificent Church of the Nativity, a sacred site that marks the very spot where Jesus was born. In the afternoon, we will journey to Ein Karem, the enchanting birthplace of St. John the Baptist. While there, we'll explore the Church of the Visitation, where the Virgin Mary shared her beautiful song of praise, the 'Magnificat,' with her cousin Elizabeth. After a fulfilling day, we'll enjoy a delicious dinner and settle in for the night at our hotel in Bethlehem.

DAY 7: BETHANY | JORDAN RIVER | JERICHO | QUMRAN | DEAD SEA

After breakfast, we'll head to Bethany to visit the church dedicated to Lazarus and then continue to the serene Jordan River for the opportunity to renew our baptismal vows. We'll stop in Jericho, the world's oldest city, for today's Mass. Next, we'll visit the Mount of Temptation, where Jesus fasted, and Qumran, home of the Dead Sea Scrolls. Finally, we'll enjoy floating in the mineral-rich Dead Sea before returning to our hotel in Bethlehem for dinner and overnight accommodations.

DAY 8: JERUSALEM — PALM SUNDAY ROUTE

Today, we explore Jerusalem, starting at the Mount of Olives and the Pater Noster, where Jesus taught the Lord's Prayer. We'll walk the Palm Sunday Route, stopping at Dominus Flevit, where Jesus wept over the city. In the Garden of Gethsemane, we'll reflect at The Rock of Agony before celebrating Mass at the Church of All Nations. We'll then visit the Chapel of the Ascension. In the afternoon, we'll head to Mount Zion to explore the Upper Room, concluding our day at St. Peter in Gallicantu, where Peter denied Jesus. We'll return to our hotel in Bethlehem for dinner and overnight accommodations.

DAY 9: JERUSALEM — VIA DOLOROSA

Our day begins with a reflective walk along the Via Dolorosa, retracing Jesus' last steps through the Old City. We'll meditate at each Station of the Cross before arriving at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, Christianity's holiest site, where Jesus was crucified and buried. After celebrating Mass, we'll visit St. Anne's Church, the traditional home of the Virgin Mary. As we pass the Ecce Homo, where Pontius Pilate declared, "Behold the man!" we'll feel a deep reverence. The journey culminates at the Wailing Wall, the holiest site in Judaism. The rest of the day is free for personal exploration or relaxation. We'll end with a farewell dinner at a local restaurant, celebrating our time together before overnight accommodations at our Bethlehem hotel.

DAY 10: RETURN HOME

This morning, we'll transfer to the airport to catch our flight home, carrying with us the rich experiences and memories from our uplifting journey.

YOUR PACKAGE INCLUDES

Air Transportation: Economy class and round-trip airfares are based on the time of the reservation. Rates and times are subject to change without notice. Airfares, once issued, are non-refundable, non-transferable, and cannot be used towards future travel.

Private Transfers: All land transportation as described in the itinerary will be by Deluxe Motor Coach. Some may be equipped with Wi-Fi service.

Hotel Accommodations: Your hotels will be first-class with double occupancy (2 people per room with a private bath). Neither Nativity Pilgrimage nor the trip coordinator are responsible for providing a roommate.

Included Meals: The meal plan offers breakfast, lunch & dinner daily, unless otherwise stated.

Baggage: Most airlines limit passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage and one (1) carry-on. All passengers should check with their airline carrier for up-to-date baggage weight and dimensions.

Airport Fees: Airport Taxes, portage, fuel surcharges and security fees

Medical Coverage: Medical coverage for the duration of your trip. Coverage details, limits, exclusions, and claims procedures are governed solely by the insurance policy documents provided by the insurer.

Tips/Gratuities: This includes tour guides, drivers, hotel service staff, and wait staff.

YOUR PACKAGE DOES NOT INCLUDE

Cancellation Insurance: We highly recommend purchasing travel insurance upon registration.

Passport/Visa Expenses: This includes any passports or additional travel documents that may be required. Passports must be valid until at least 6 months from your return date. Travelers are solely responsible for obtaining and carrying all required passports, visas, vaccination documentation, and other entry requirements imposed by destination countries.

Personal Expenses: Laundry, beverages (including wine, liquor, mineral water, tea, coffee, etc.), meals or food items not listed on the included menu plan, and any excess or additional luggage.

Non-itinerary fees: Any sightseeing or service fees or personal items that are not specifically mentioned as being included in the itinerary.

Non-included meals: You are responsible for any meals not specified in your itinerary.

GENERAL TRAVEL INFORMATION

Group Air Policy: Group Air differs from individually purchased airline tickets in that it is subject to the terms and conditions of the airlines. For this reason, we need to receive your registration and full payment by the payment deadline. After that date, registrations may be subject to a different air rate, ticketing method, or on a different airline. Additional fees and charges may apply. Group air flights are confirmed 60 - 90 days prior to departure.

Point of Departure: If your departure city is not listed on the brochure, indicate which airport you would like to depart from on the registration form. We will provide you with the best possible price and flight schedule to connect with the group. Additional fees and charges may apply.

Land-Only Option: If you would like to book your own air travel, indicate on your registration form that you want the land-only option. This amount equals to the total tour price minus \$800 for all destinations except Mexico, which is minus \$350. By booking your own air, you may select your seat, airline, and travel schedule, use airline miles/points, provide airline reward program information, and make any special requests directly with the airline. No changes can be made after the final payment deadline. Land-only services begin and end at the hotels unless you are able to meet the group at the airport. Land-only travelers are responsible for their own airport transfers.

IMPORTANT POLICIES

Travel/Scheduling Changes: Flight schedules, aircraft type, routing, departure airports, and carriers are subject to change by the airline without notice.

Seat Assignments: The airline carrier selects seat assignments for group air, not the tour operator. Seat upgrades are available for registered travelers, by request. Quoted rates for an upgrade are subject to change until payment is received. Some upgrades are not available until the group tickets are issued.

Single Room: Tour price is based on double occupancy. If you'd like a single room, there is an additional cost per person as specified on the registration form. Single rooms are limited and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Seat Upgrades: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives an upgrade or seat location request, we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee the acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

Special Requests: Once Nativity Pilgrimage receives a special request, such as a wheelchair, food, etc., we will contact the airlines to finalize your request. We cannot guarantee acceptance of this request as it is subject to availability and pricing (which changes daily).

TRAVELER CONDUCT POLICY

Nativity Pilgrimage reserves the right to remove any traveler whose behavior is disruptive, unsafe, unlawful, abusive, or interferes with the enjoyment or safety of other participants. No refund shall be provided for unused portions of the trip.

HEALTH/FITNESS REQUIREMENTS

Travelers are responsible for determining that they are physically and medically capable of participating. Travelers requiring special accommodations must notify Nativity Pilgrimage at the time of registration.

BOOKING CONDITIONS

Registration: A \$300 non-refundable deposit per person is required at the time of registration. No reservation will be processed without a deposit.

Payment Deadline: Full payment is due (03/12/2027) 100 days before departure. Late registrations received after the deadline require an additional \$100 (subject to availability). If payment is not made in full 50 days prior to departure, your payments are non-refundable.

Payment Methods: We accept major credit cards, checks, money orders, and Zelle payments. There is an additional 3% fee for each credit card transaction.

LATE PAYMENT POLICY

Customers will receive late fees if they are not paid in full:

- 100-61 days prior to departure: \$150
- 60-30 days prior to departure: \$300
- 30 days or less prior to departure: Subject to cancellation

Customers are also responsible for any difference in fare due to late payment (subject to availability). Refusal to pay will be considered a cancellation.

CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY

Cancellation penalties are assessed based on the date written notice of cancellation is received:

- 100 days or more prior to departure: \$300 deposit
- 99-50 days prior to departure: 50% of total trip cost
- 49 days or less prior to departure: 100% of total trip cost

FORCE MAJEURE

Nativity Pilgrimage shall not be liable for delays, cancellations, changes, losses, or damages resulting from acts of God, natural disasters, pandemics, government actions, border closures, airline disruptions, labor disputes, terrorism, civil unrest, or other events beyond its reasonable control.

TRAVEL INSURANCE OPTIONS

Medical Coverage: Every pilgrim traveling with Nativity will receive complimentary medical insurance that provides coverage for the full duration of your trip. Coverage details, limits, exclusions, and claims procedures are governed solely by the insurance policy documents provided by the insurer.

Trip Cancellation Insurance: We also strongly recommend purchasing trip cancellation insurance (available at an additional cost) to safeguard your travel investment in case unforeseen circumstances require you to cancel. Important: If you plan to purchase Cancel for Any Reason (CFAR) coverage, it must be purchased within 14 days of registration.
